Installation Instructions for PVGD15-SC

IMPORTANT:

Before you begin, make sure you familiarize yourself with all the parts and fully read the instructions. We recommend a GFCI Outlet is installed or accessible within 3.5 feet of where the drawer will be installed.




TOOLS NECESSARY:

Screw gun or Phillips screwdriver and tape measure. NOTE: If screw gun has a clutch, set to lowest setting so as not to over tighten and/or strip screws.

PARTS IDENTIFICATION:

1	18" Synchronized Undermount Slides (Assembled)	2 pcs
2	6-way Adjustable Zinc Undermount Clips (Assembled)	2 pcs
3	Powered Vanity Drawer	1 pcs
4	Stainless Steel Canisters	2 pcs
5	Rear Mounting Bracket	1 pcs
6	Cable Management Arm Bracket	1 pcs
7	Microswitch	1 pcs
8	Cable Management Arm	1 pcs
9	Power Strip	1 pcs





STEP 3 - Install Drawer Slides in Cabinet STEP 4 - Reattach Unit to Drawer Slides Attach rear mounting brackets to back panel. Offset from side panel and bottom panels as shown. Reattach drawer to slides and screw cable arm back to slide rear bracket using 2x M5 x 6 mm screws. Attach slides to brackets. Offset slides by 1/4" from face frame. Use supplied 10x #6 x 1/2" to attach the slide to the face frame and rear brackets to cabinet. STEP 5 - Close the Drawer & Inspect STEP 6 - Connect the Unit & Test Close the drawer and make sure the power cable does not get pinched by the drawer. Connect the powered vanity and test power works correctly. NOTE: Powered vanity is designed so power cuts off from the outlet when the drawer is in the closed position.
