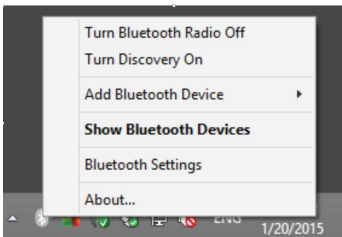

Installation

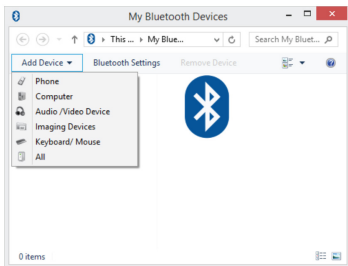
- 1.** Insert the Bluetooth adapter into an available USB port on your computer.
- 2.** The driver for this product will install automatically upon connection of the Bluetooth adapter. If it does not auto-install, or does not fully install, you can get the driver file at www.tripplite.com/support.

Pairing

1. Right-click on the Bluetooth icon in the lower-right corner of your computer screen to pull up the menu.

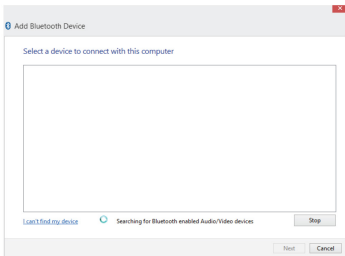


2. Click on the *Add Bluetooth Device* option, selecting the type of device you are adding (e.g. Phone, Computer, Audio/Video Device, etc.).

3. Make sure your Bluetooth device is on and in pairing mode, so it can be found by the Bluetooth adapter. When it appears in the list, select it and click *Next* to proceed.



4. After pairing is completed, click *Finish*.

Note: When pairing, you may be prompted to enter a pairing code. Enter this code on both your computer and device. If using headphones that do not allow for a code to be entered, try using the code 0000 or 1234 on your computer only, or consult the owner's manual of the headphones for instructions on how to proceed.
