



## SPECIFICATION SERVICE SADDLE DOUBLE STRAP LARGE TAP MODEL 357



#### **APPLICATIONS**

- Typical Uses
  - Tapping large branch connections on new or existing pipe
  - Installing air/vacuum valves, pitot tubes, drain valves, or other miscellaneous service equipment
  - Installing pipe supports, hangers, or sign mounting brackets
- Standard Pipe Sizes
  - 6" to 12"nominal
- Standard Taps
  - NPT: 3" and 4"
- Type of Pipe
  - PVC, Cast Iron, Carbon Steel, Stainless Steel
- Working Pressure
  - Up to 150 psi depending on type of pipe, type of repair, pipe diameter, service conditions, and installation workmanship

#### **MATERIALS**

#### Body

- Cast using Ductile Iron 65-45-12 per ASTM A536
- Flexi-Coat<sup>®</sup> fusion bonded epoxy finish which meets application methods AWWA C213
- Open ears provide easy slip on installation and removal of nuts are not required preventing lost hardware
- Canted ears for maximum tangential tightening of bale or strap
- Wraparound design provides maximum pipe support, reinforcement, and sealing pressure
- Wide skirt and heavy tapping boss provides excellent stability on the pipe

#### Gasket

- Nitrile (Buna-N) per ASTM D2000
- Certified to NSF/ANSI 61-G & 372
- Compounded to resist water, oil, natural gas, acids, alkalies, most (aliphatic) hydrocarbon fluids, and many other chemicals
- Temperature range: -20°F to +180°F
- Pressure energized concave wedge gasket provides an effective seal with no rolling or binding on installation
- Gasket is fully cemented in a cavity to hold it in place

#### Strap

- Type 304 Stainless Steel per ASTM A240
- Formed using 14GA x 2.00" strip
- Strap distributes load across a larger surface area preventing damage to non-rigid pipe types
- Relevant product information placed on strap i.e. O.D. range, part number, etc.

#### Welding

- Welds accomplished using qualified welders
- GMAW weld process utilized
- Welds passivated to preserve corrosion resistance

#### Stud

- Type 304 Stainless Steel per ASTM A276
- 5/8"-11UNC x 7.00" long, Stud welded to Strap
- Rolled threads for improved physical characteristics, greater thread accuracy, and smooth surface finish

#### Nut

- Type 304 Stainless Steel GR. 8 per ASTM A194
- Fluoropolymer coated to prevent galling
- 5/8"-11UNC, Heavy Hex Semi-Finished

#### Washer

- Type 304 Stainless Steel per ASTM A240
- 5/8" Type A Plain
- Utilized to preserve corrosion resistance of epoxy coated surfaces and increase bearing surface


