Maintain Accurate Estimates

- Spend the extra time to price out each part of the job.
- Write into your estimates contingencies on unknowns like electrical or plumbing.

Understand Material Costs

- Price each material based on its current cost versus historical costs.
- Always add a 20% contingency.

Be Ready to Pivot When Plans Change

- Update the contract by adding new material and labor costs that will be required due to changes.
- Ensure the client is aware of the price changes they'll incur.

Worry About the Small Stuff

- Being detail-oriented can save you money. Remember to account for all supplies needed.

Manage Your Site with Care

- Make sure the jobsite is always organized by doing daily cleanup and tracking material usage.

Use the Right Team

- Hire crew members that are adequately trained, can perform the duties assigned, and have protective gear to ensure job site safety.
